This funding will be used to

- Raise the results of all students in Years 1 to 6, on Semester 1 and 2 report cards in the learning areas of: English, Mathematics and Science.
 - English - % A or B to 50% or higher and % C or better to 80% or higher
 - Math - % A or B to 50% or higher and % C or better to 80% or higher
 - Science - % A or B to 50% or higher and % C or better to 85% or higher

Our initiatives include

- Developing teacher understanding of Australian Curriculum allowing teachers to identify aspects of the achievement standard to be taught in each relevant unit during full implementation.
- Describing target content (procedural and declarative knowledge) and content necessary to learn the target content as Proficiency Scales to support planning, teaching, assessing and moderating.


Our school will improve student outcomes by
